Gateways Staff, Evergreen Students,
Green Hill, and Maple Lane Residents
and Staff

Outputs:

Gateways College Prep Class meets once per week at Maple Lane in
Fall, Winter, and Spring Quarters. (approximately 10 TESC Students
and 15 Maple Lane Students participate.

Activities:

Small and Large Group
Seminar (reading and
discussing a common
college level text)

Activities:

Writing Skills (Writing weekly
response papers to the assigned
text) Journaling (10 minute free
write)

Activities:

Peer/Mentor Interaction
(TESC Students and Maple
Lane Students)

Outcomes:

Participants will develop
their voice and will be
able to communicate
effectively and across
cultures.

Participants will have to
opportunity to engage in a
meaningful positive
peer/mentor relationship
